

Guidelines & Agreements for Attending Live Service of Spiritual Life Center

The MSU management has set up strict guidelines for maintaining safe practices – and we have agreed to abide by these. In the downloadable [document link](#) (see below) you will note a Daily Health Screening Survey. Each of us will be **required** to fill out this form (no more than 24 hours before we arrive) and to submit this to an **MSU employee** at the door of the Center before we can enter. ([Download form](#))

In addition, the following practices will be required by each of us:

1. Wearing a face mask
2. Maintaining social distance of at least 6 feet
3. Using only the seats marked in the Auditorium

Also, we have agreed to the following:

1. Music will be pre-recorded and shown on the screen
2. No papers will be set out in the Lobby for people to pick up
3. No offering bags will be passed. Rather there will be a jar in the lobby
4. There will be no coffee or food before or after the Service
5. Everyone will be asked to depart after the Service without gathering in the lobby. People can meet outside or at a restaurant if they choose
6. People can submit Prayer Requests as done recently – by email or phone

No doubt many of these restrictions will be loosened as the pandemic abates. Meanwhile, we join the MSU Center in erring on the side of caution in order to protect one another.
